

This Indenture, made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 1885 by  
and between R. O. Jones, and S. A. Jones his wife of the  
County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part  
and Hubbard Brothers of the County of Jackson and  
State of Missouri of the second part:

Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in  
consideration of the sum of One and  $\frac{1}{2}$  Dollars the  
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the  
debt hereinafter mentioned do by these presents grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the  
second part their heirs and assigns, all the following  
described Real Estate, situated in the County of Douglas  
and State of Kansas to wit:

All of Lot No. Five (5) in Block No. Twenty-three (23)  
Sinclairs addition to the City of Lawrence said lot  
being Fifty feet front by One hundred and seventeen  
feet deep and having thereon a new frame one  
story house containing four rooms and cellar  
exclusive of pantry also a coal or wood house and  
privy - said premises being worth One Thousand  
Dollars, said property is entirely free of liens and  
encumbrances, with the exception of Two Hundred  
Dollars secured by Mortgage in favor of W. T. Sinclair  
which sum is due Jan'y. 1<sup>st</sup> 1887, with interest  
at seven and one half ( $7\frac{1}{2}$ ) per cent from Jan'y 1<sup>st</sup>  
1885.

To have and to hold the same, together with all  
and singular the rights, privileges, tenements, heredita-  
ments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in  
anywise appertaining, forever, upon this express condi-  
tion to-wit: That Whereas, R. O. Jones and George  
Almond have purchased certain merchandise of  
said Hubbard Bros. as witnessed by their contract  
in writing duly entered into with said Hubbard  
Bros. which contract bears date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of  
October 1885 and whereas by the terms of said  
contract said merchandise is to be taken and paid  
for by said Jones and Almond within the  
periods named in said contract and at prices  
therein also named, and whereas Hubbard  
Bros. have agreed in said contract to supply  
certain goods and cash to said Jones and  
Almond subject to the conditions of said
