

This Indenture, Made this 1st day of December A.D.
1885 Between Shirbal L. Kersey and Martha T. his
wife of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of
the first part and Charles Rothholz of Douglas
County, in the State of Kansas of the second part:
Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part,
in consideration of the sum of Six hundred and $\frac{50}{100}$
Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
do, by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and
convey unto said party of the second part, his
heirs and assigns, all the following described
Real Estate, situated in the County of Douglas
and State of Kansas to wit:

The North West Quarter of the South East quarter
Section (34) Thirty four. Township thirteen (13) Range
Twenty one (21) forty acres more or less.
Together with all

Provided Always, And these presents are upon
this express condition, that whereas, said Shubal
Kersey and Martha T. his wife have this day
executed and delivered one certain promissory
note in writing to said party of the second
part, of which the following is a copy.
