

This Indenture, Made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of December in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty five 1885 between George M. Brubaker  
of Douglas County in the County of Douglas  
and State of Kansas, of the first part, and and  
Asbury Burnett of Douglas County in the State  
of Kansas of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part,  
in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred  
and fifty \$250 Dollars, to him duly paid  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
has sold and by these presents does grant,  
bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party  
of the second part his heirs and assigns  
forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated  
in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas  
described as follows, to wit:

The south Thirty (30) acres of the North one  
Hundred and Thirty (130) acres of the north-  
west quarter of Section No two (2) in Township  
No. twelve (12) south of range No. Seventeen (17)  
east said Thirty acres being described by notes  
and bounds under Warranty Deed of same  
from Asbury Burnett, with the appurtenances  
and all the estate, title and interest of the  
said part of the first part therein. And the  
said George M. Brubaker does hereby covenant  
and agree that at the delivery hereof that  
he is the lawful owner of the premises  
above granted and seized of a good and  
indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free  
and clear of all incumbrances. This Grant  
is intended as a Mortgage to secure the  
payment of the sum of Two Hundred and  
Fifty Dollars according to the terms of one  
certain promissory note this day executed  
by the said George M. Brubaker to the  
said party of the second part, of which  
the following is a copy \$250 Leavenworth
