Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part,
in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred
Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, hath sold, and by
these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and
mortgage to the said parties of the second
part, their heirs and assigns forever, all that
tract or parcel of land situated in the County
of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as
follows, to wit:
