This Indenture, made this 13th day of January A.D., 1886 between Joe Snyder and Mary his wife of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the first part and Charles Lothholz of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, that said part of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bar, gain, sell, and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described Real Estate, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to-wit: Block Ninety one Block Ninety two Block One hundred and fifteen Block One hundred and sixteen Block One hundred and twenty nine Block One hundred and thirty Block One hundred and fifty all in the city of Eudora County and State aforesaid.

So have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever:

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said Joe Snyder has this day executed and delivered two certain promissory notes in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following are copies:

\$200 - Eudora Kansas January 13th 1886

One year after date we promise to pay to the order of Charles Lothholz Two Hundred Dollars at his office at Eudora Ks. Value received. with interest at ten per cent per annum after date until paid.

Two years after date we promise to pay to the order of Charles Lothholz Three hundred Dollars at his office at Eudora Ks Value received with interest at ten per cent
