

This Indenture, Made this Eight day of February  
in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight  
hundred and Eighty Six between Florentine Mignot  
of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas  
of the first part and William S. Sinclair and  
Mary J. Smith of the second part:

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first  
part, for and in consideration of the sum  
of Eight Hundred Dollars, to him in hand paid  
by the said parties of the second part, the  
receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged,  
hath granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and  
by these presents doth grant bargain, sell and  
convey unto the said parties of the second  
part, and to their heirs and assigns forever,  
all the following described piece and parcel of  
land lying and situate in the County of  
Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit: The West  
Half of the North East Quarter of Section No  
Four (4) in Township No Fifteen (15) South of Range  
No Twenty One (21) East of the 6<sup>th</sup> principal Meridian  
containing Seventy Eight (78) acres of land  
more or less.

To have and to hold the same, with all  
and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances  
therunto belonging, unto the parties of the second  
part, and to their heirs and assigns forever.

And the said party of the first part doth hereby  
covenant and agree, that at the delivery hereof  
he is the lawful owner of the premises above  
granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible  
estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of  
all incumbrances, and that he will Warrant  
and Defend the same in the quiet and  
peaceable possession of said parties of the second  
part, their heirs and assigns forever, against  
all persons lawfully claiming the same.

Provided Always, And these presents  
are upon this express condition, that whereas,  
the said Florentine Mignot is justly indebted  
to the said Wm S. Sinclair and Mary J. Smith  
the principal sum of Eight Hundred  
Dollars, lawful money of the United States of
