This Mortgage is junior to a Mortgage of even date herewith upon the same real estate for \$2250⁰⁰ in which each party is the same as herein, and upon a failure on the part of the first party to perform any agreement made by them in said prior Mortgage or upon the payment of said prior Mortgage in full before the same matures, the note secured hereby becomes due at once, and this Mortgage may be thereupon foreclosed.


