

This Indenture, Made this 20th day of February
A.D. 1886 between Philander Blackledge and Hannah
Blackledge of Douglas County, in the State of
Kansas of the first part, and James M. Davis of
Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the second
part:

Witnesseth, That said partie of the first part, in
consideration of the sum of Sixty nine $\frac{75}{100}$ Dollars
Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey
unto said party of the second part, his heirs and
assigns, all the following described Real Estate,
situated in Douglas County, and State of Kansas
to wit:

A part of the North East quarter of the North
East quarter of Section Twenty eight (28) Township
Thirteen (13) Range Twenty one (21), Commencing
at a point on the section Twenty eight (28) rods
South of the North east corner of said Section thence
west Ten (10) rods, thence North One hundred & Eighty
one (181) feet, thence East Ten (10) rods to the Section
line, thence South One hundred & Eighty one (181)
feet to the place of beginning +

So Have and to Hold the same, Together with
all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise
appertaining, forever:

Provided Always, and these presents are
upon this express condition, that whereas said
Philander Blackledge and Hannah Blackledge has
this day executed and delivered one certain prom-
issory note in writing to said party of the second
part, of which the following is a copy:
