Witnesseth, I that said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described Real Estate, situated in Douglas County, and State of Kansas to wit:

The west half of the north east quarter of section
number two (2) Township twelve (12) south Range seventeen
(17) east
