

This Indenture, made this First day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six, between Samson Harshman and Sophia Harshman, his wife of Gillers Springs Prop. in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Willis C. Bradley of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

The North West Quarter (N. W. 1/4) of Section Fifteen (15) Township Fifteen (15) Range Nineteen. (19)

To have and to hold the same, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part, do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

Provided Always, And this instrument is made upon the following conditions, to-wit:

First. Said Samson Harshman and Sophia Harshman are justly indebted unto said party of the second part, in the principal sum of Seven Hundred Dollars, being for a loan thereof made by the said party of the second part to the said parties of the first part, and payable according to the tenor and effect of one certain First
