This Indenture, made this second day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighty six between Grace F. Finney and Frank Finney her husband of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Caroline Houghtelin of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred and Fifty five \$ Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: An undivided two thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) of Lot Number One Hundred (100) Louisiana street in the City of Lawrence with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Grace F. Finney does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a mortgage, to secure the payment of the sum of Eleven Hundred and Fifty five \$ Dollars according to the terms of two certain promissory notes this day executed and delivered by the said Grace F. and Frank Finney to the said party of the second part; payable \$500 in two years from date and \$65.50 in four years from date
