 of April in the year of our Lord One Thou-
 sand Eight Hundred and Eighty six by
 and between Albert Bell and Lucinda
 Bell his wife of Willow Springs Town-
 ship of the County of Douglas and State
 of Kansas, party of the first part, and
 E. N. Van Hosen of Lawrence, Kansas,
 party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party
 of the first part, for and in consideration
 of the sum of One thousand Dollars,
 in hand paid by the said party of the
 second part, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged have Granted, Bargained and
 Sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bar-
 gain, Sell, Convey and Confirm, unto the
 said party of the second part his heirs,
 successors or assigns, Forever, all of the fol-
 lowing described tract, piece or parcels of
 land lying and situate in the County
 of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Fifty two (52) acres in the north-
 west quarter of Section Twenty (20) Town-
 ship Fourteen (14) Range Nineteen (19)
 described as follows. Beginning at the south-
 west corner of the Northwest quarter of Sec-
 tion Twenty (20) Tp. Fourteen (14) Range
 Nineteen (19). East One hundred and
 seven (107) rods: North Eighty (80) rods:
 West One hundred and four (104) rods:
 South Eighty (80) rods to place of beginning
