

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred ~~50~~ Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Sots number One hundred and fifty (150) and One hundred and fifty two (152) Kentucky Street in the City of Lawrence

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said Martin L. Rice does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance free and clear of all encumbrances.
