This Indenture, Made this 19 day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six, between Lindley H. Cox and Mary H. Cox his wife (being of lawful age,) of the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Edward Russell of Lawrence Kansas of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars, then in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, the following tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

The East half of the Northeast quarter of Section thirty six (36) and North half of Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section thirty six (36) all in Township twelve (12) of Range twenty (20) containing 100 acres more or less according to U.S. Survey, and being the homestead of the parties of the first part.

with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. and the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances; that they have good right to sell and convey said premises, and that they will warrant and Defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons.
