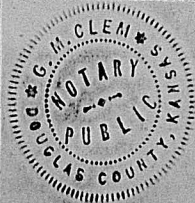

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 18th day of September, A. D. 1952, between Don D. Darnell and Marguerite Darnell, his wife of Johnson County, Kansas and Howard E. Burnett and Barbara Burnett, his wife of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and Douglas County State Bank, a Corporation of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Nine thousand five hundred and no DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell, and Convey unto said party of the second part, its heirs and assigns, all the following-described real estate, situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the Section line Four Hundred Eighty and eight tenths (480.8) Feet North of the Southeast corner of Section Six (6), Township Thirteen (13) South, Range Twenty (20), thence West Three Hundred Twenty-seven (327) feet, thence North One Hundred Sixteen and three tenths (116.3) feet, thence East Three Hundred Twenty-seven (327) feet, thence South One Hundred Sixteen and Three Tenths (116.3) feet to place of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.
