be applied to the payment of taxes, insurance premiums and other charges thereon, or in reduction of the indebt-edness secured by this mortgage; and the rents, issues and profits are hereby specifically pledged to the payment of said indebtedness and of all other obligations which may accrue under the terms hereof.

- 3. If the note and mortgage or either of them shall be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or foreclosure, or if Mortgagee voluntarily or involuntarily becomes or is made a party to any suit or proceeding relating to the premises or to this mortgage or said note, Mortgagors shall reimburse Mortgagee for its reasonable attorney's fees, costs and expense of procuring abstracts or other evidences of title and title insurance in constitutions of the process connection therewith.
- 4. If any proceedings shall be brought to foreclose this mortgage or to collect the indebtedness hereby secured, Mortgagee shall be entitled as a matter of right, without notice to Mortgagers or any person claiming under them and without regard to the adequacy of the security or whether the same shall then be occupied by the owner of the equity of relemption as a homestead, to the immediate appointment of a receiver with power to take possession of the premises, lease the same, collect all rentals and profits thereof and hold and apply the receipts as the court may order for maintenance of the security and on account of said indebtedness.
- 5. Mortgagee shall be subrogated to the lien of any and all prior incumbrances, liens or charges paid and discharged from the proceeds of the note hereby secured, and even though said prior liens have been released of record, the repayment of said note shall be secured by such liens on the portions of said premises affected. thereby to the extent of such payments, respectively.
- 6. Whenever by the terms of this instrument or of said note Mortgagee is given any option, such option may be exercised when the right accrues, or at any time thereafter.
- 7. All Mortgagors shall be jointly and severally liable for fulfillment of their covenants and agreements herein contained, and all provisions of this mortgage shall inure to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors, grantees, lessees and assigns of the parties hereto, respectively.
- 8. All payments made under the provisions of this mortgage or the note hereby secured which may be construed as interest shall not, in the aggregate over the contracted for in writing.
