- (I) ground rents, if any, taxes, assessments, fire and other hazard insurance premiums;
- (II) interest on the note secured hereby; and
- (III) amortization of the principal of said note.

Any deficiency in the amount of such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. The Mortgage may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to four per centum (4%) of any installment which is not paid within fifteen (15) days of the due date thereof, but in no event shall this or other provisions be construed so as to authorize collection of any sum in excess of that permitted by law.

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- 3. If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (a) of paragraph 2 preceding shall crossed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee for ground rents, taxes and assessments or bearance premiums, as the case may be, such excess shall be credited on subsequent payments to be said by the Mortgagor for such items. If, however, such monthly payments shall not be sufficient to pay said these when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagoe say assess to preserve to make up the deficiency within thirty (30) days after written notice from the Mortgagoes stating the amount of the deficiency, which notice may be given by mail. If at any time the Mortgagoes stating the amount of the deficiency, which notice may be given by mail. If at any time the Mortgagoe shall tender to the Mortgagoe, in accordance with the provisions of the note secured hereby, full payment of the entire indebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagoe in computing the amount of such indebtedness, shall credit to the secount of the Mortgagor any credit balance remaining under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 2 hereof. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby or if the Mortgagoe acquires the property otherwise after default, the Mortgagoe shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, any credit balance accumulated under (a) of paragraph 2 on the interest accrued and unpaid and the balance to the principal then remaining unpaid on said note.
- 4. He will pay all ground rents, taxes, assessments, water rates, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, or impositions, levied upon said premises except when payment for all such items has theretofere been made under (a) of paragraph 2 hereof, and he will promptly deliver the official receipts therefor to the Mortgagee. In default thereof the Mortgagee may pay the same.
- 5. He shall not commit or permit waste; and shall maintain the property in as good condition as at present, reasonable wear and tear excepted. Upon any failure so to maintain, Mortgagee, at its option, may cause reasonable maintenance work to be performed at the cost of Mortgagor. Any amounts paid therefor by Mortgagee shall bear interest at four per centum (4%) per annum, shall thereupon become a part of the indebtedness secured by this instrument, ratably and on a parity with all other indebtedness secured hereby, and shall be payable thirty (80) days after demand.
- 6. He will continuously maintain hazard insurance, of such type or types and amounts as Mortgagee may from time to time require, on the improvements now or hereafter on said premises, and except when payment for all such premiums has therefore been made under (a) of paragraph 2 hereof, he will premptly pay when due any premiums therefor. Upon default thereof, Mortgagee may pay the same. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagee and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by it and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. In event of loss he will give immediate notice by mail to the Mortgagee who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by the Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hareby authorised and directed to make payment for such loss directly to the Mortgagee instead of to the Mortgagor and the Mortgagee jointly. The insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by the Mortgagee at its option, either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage, or other transfer of title to the mortgaged property in extinguishment of the debt secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.
- 7. Upon the request of the Mortgages the Mortgager shall execute and deliver a supplemental note or notes for the sum or sums advanced by the Mortgages for the alteration, modernization, or improvement it Mortgager's request, or for maintenance of said premises, for taxes or assessments against the same and for any other purpose elsewhere authorized hereunder. Said note or notes shall be secured hereby on a parity with and as fully as if the advance evidenced thereby were included in the note first described above. Said supplemental note or notes shall bear interest at four per centum (4%) per annum and shall be payable in approximately equal monthly payments for such period as may be agreed upon by the Mortgages. Failing to agree on the maturity, the whole of the sum or sums so advanced shall be due and payable thirty (80) days after demand by the Mortgages. In no event shall the maturity extend beyond the ultimate maturity of the note first described above.
- the there shall be a default in any of the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then any sums owing by the Mortgager to the Mortgagee shall, at the option of the Mortgagee shall then have the right to enter into the possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents, issues and profits thereof. In the event of any default, as herein described, this mortgage may be foreclosed. Appraisement is hereby waived.
