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- 3. If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (a) of paragraph 2 preceding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee for ground rents, taxes and assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor for such items. If, however, such monthly payments shall not be sufficient to pay such items when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency within thirty (30) days after written notice from the Mortgagee stating the amount of the deficiency, which notice may be given by mail. If at any time the Mortgagor shall tender to the Mortgagee, in accordance with the provisions of the note secured fereby, full payment of the entire indebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagee in computing the amount of such indebtedness, shall credit to the account of the Mortgagor any credit balance remaining under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 2 hereof. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby or if the Mortgagee acquires the property otherwise after default, the Mortgagee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, any credit balance accumulated under (a) of paragraph 2 on the interest accumed and unpaid and the balance to the principal then remaining unpaid on said note.

In event of loss he will give immediate notice by mail to the Mortgagee who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by the Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is bareby anthorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to the Mortgagee instead of to the Mortgager and the Mortgagee jointly. The insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied to Mortgagee at its option, either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restains a sepair of the property damaged. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage, or other transfer of the intertaged property in extinguishment of the debt secured hereby, all right, title and the mortgager in and to any insurance policies them in force shall pass to the purchaser or

Notice of the exercise of any option granted herein to the Mortgages is not required to be given. The covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, securiors, schools and assigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular number shall include the phiral, the pixal the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders, and the term "Mortgages" shall include any payes of the indebtedness hereby secured or any transferre thereof whether by operation of law or otherwise.
