under the laws of the United States, Mortgagee:

WITNESSETH, That the Mortgagee, for and in consideration of the sum of - - - Fifty-Four
Hundred Fifty and no/100 - - - Dollars (\$ 9450.00), the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged, does by these presents mortgage and warrant unto the Mortgagee, its successors and
assigns, forever, the following-described property, situated in the county of Douglas
State of Kansas, to wit:

the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

(It is understood and agreed that this is a purchase money mortgage)

Any amount contained herein, constituting the
basis of this mortgage and note secured thereby
are to be governed by Title III of the Servicemen's
Readjustment Act of 1944, as amended, and the
applicable state-adopted amendments.

Section 10 of this mortgage is hereby amended to read as follows: That the mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose upon the mortgaged premises in accordance with the provisions of the Servicemen's Readjustment Act of 1944, as amended, and the applicable state-adopted amendments.
