Anthony or order the principal sum of Bight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) with interest from August 1, 1953, at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum on the unpaid balance until paid, the principal and interest being payable at the home of Z. Anthony in Satanta, Kansas, or at such other place as the legal holder hereof may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Sixty-nine and 92/100 Dollars (\$69.92) commencing on the 1st day of September, 1953, and the 1st day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of the entire indebtedness evidenced hereby, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the 1st day of August, 1966.
