

Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Marion County, extending south through Section 24, to the southeast corner of said Section 24, thence continuing south through Sections 23, 22, 21, 20, 19, 18, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, to the northeast corner of said Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Marion County, to a point in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 23, thence southerly to a point in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 26, thence continuing west through said Sections 26 and 27 to a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the northeast corner of said Section 27, all in said township, range and county.

Line No. 14—A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately one and seventeen hundredths (1.17) miles in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located in the southeast corner of Section 34, Township 14 South, Range 3 West, Saline County, thence southerly through Sections 33, 32, 31, 30, 29, 28, 27, to the northeast corner of the Company located in the Force Base No. 2 electric substation of the Company located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 27, in said township, range and county.

Line No. 15—A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately three and fifty-two hundredths (3.52) miles in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 30, Township 12 South, Range 20 East, Douglas County, extending south through said Section 30 to the north bank of the Kansas River, thence continuing southerly across the Kansas River through said Section 30 to the northeast corner of Section 31, thence south to a point in the southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 31, all in said township, range and county; thence continuing southerly through Section 6, Township 13 South, Range 20 East, Douglas County, to approximately the East-West One Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) section line of said Section 6, thence east through said Sections 6 and 5 to the southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 4, thence continuing south through said Section to the Co-op Farm Chemical Co. electric substation located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 4, all in said township, range and county.

Line No. 16—A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately six hundredths (.60) miles in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located in the southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 17, Township 19 South, Range 11 East, Lyon County, extending west to the Emporia South Avenue electric substation of the Company, located in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 17.

Line No. 17—A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately four (4.00) miles in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located in the northeast corner of Section 17, Township 22 South, Range 11 East, Greenwood County, extending west through said Sections 17 and 18, all in said township, range and county; thence southerly through Sections 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, to the Browning electric substation of the Company, located in the northeast corner of Section 15 in said township, range and county.

Line No. 18—A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately two and twenty-five hundredths (2.25) miles in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 17, Township 22 South, Range 11 East, Greenwood County, extending east through Section 16 to a point in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 16, thence continuing southerly to the southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 16, thence continuing east through Section 16 to the northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 16, thence continuing east through Section 16 to the northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 15, all in said township, range and county.

GAS TRANSMISSION LINES LOCATED IN THE STATE OF KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Line 1—Ulysses 30" to Meade County 12" line: A certain sixteen (16) inch steel pipe gas transmission line approximately twenty and twenty hundredths (20.20) miles in length commencing at a point of connection with the Ulysses 20 inch gas line of the Company in the southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 13, Township 29 South, Range 25 West, Ford County, and extending in a southerly direction through Sections 13, 14, 23, 26 and 35 in said township, range and county; thence continuing southerly through Sections 2, 3, 10, 19, 27, 27, 28 and 33, Township 30 South,
