WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand and no DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby present, Grant, Bargain, Sell, and Convey unto said party
of the second part, and ~~hereby assigns~~ assigns, all the following-described real estate, situated in Douglas
County and State of Kansas, to wit:

Beginning at a point 660 feet West of and 349.28 feet South of the
Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section Six (6), Township
Thirteen (13) South, Range Twenty (20) East of the Sixth Principal
Meridian; thence running South parallel to the East line of said Quarter
Section 116.8 feet; thence running West parallel to the North line of
said Quarter Section 380.5 feet to the East line of the Right of Way
conveyed to the Leavenworth, Lawrence and Galveston Railroad Company;
thence in a Northerly direction along the East line of said Right of

or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums,
and interest thereon, shall and by these presents become due and payable at the option of the holder hereof, and said party
