RELEASE OF FIRST MORTGAGE INDENTURE

WHEREAS, by its certain First Mortgage Indenture dated as of December 15, 1941 (but actually executed on December 31, 1941), THE CENTRAL WEST UTILITY COMPANY, a Kansas corporation, granted, bargained, sold, warranted, conveyed, transferred and assigned unto the undersigned, THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF KANSAS CITY, a corporation organized under the banking laws of the United States of America, and REECE A. GARDNER, of Jackson County, Missouri, as Trustees, the property and premises, real, personal and mixed, described in said First Mortgage Indenture as security for the payment of the principal and interest of all bonds issued pursuant to the terms of said indenture according to their tenor and effect and the terms of said indenture and for the performance of its covenants and obligations therein contained, and

WHEREAS, said First Mortgage Indenture was duly recorded both as a real estate mortgage and as a chattel mortgage on January 9, 1942, in Book 350, at page 21, in the office of the Recorder of Deeds for Clay County, Missouri, and was duly recorded both as a real estate mortgage and as a chattel mortgage on January 6, 1942, in Book 175, at page 352, in the office of the Recorder of Deeds for Clinton County, Missouri, and

WHEREAS, said First Mortgage Indenture was duly recorded as a real estate mortgage and filed as a chattel mortgage in Dickinson, Douglas, Johnson, Leavenworth, Marion, Morris and Wyandotte Counties, Kansas, in accordance with the following, to-wit:
