

A telephone line extending northwesterly from Section 36-T.28S-R.1W, Sedgwick County, Kansas, on the Douglas in Butler County, to Wichita in Sedgwick County, system as described in the Original Indenture, page 122, paragraph (1) to Hession Compressor Station in Section 8-T.28S-R.1W, Harvey County, Kansas, consisting of 6 miles of telephone wire on foreign poles in Sedgwick County, Kansas, and 2.2 miles of pole line and wire and 22.2 miles of telephone wire on foreign poles in Harvey County, Kansas.

A telephone line extending southwesterly from Section 14-T.28S-R.6W, Reno County, Kansas, to Section 22-T.28S-R.1W, on the Douglas in Butler County, to Wichita in Sedgwick County, system as described in the Original Indenture, page 122, paragraph (1), consisting of 2.2 miles of telephone wire on foreign poles in Reno County, Kansas.

A telephone line extending west from Section 19-T.27N-R.10W, Alfalfa County, Oklahoma, from a point on the branch telephone line to Corwin Compressor Station, as described in the Original Indenture, page 121, to Agra Compressor Station in Section 36-T.28N-R.1W, Woods County, Oklahoma, said telephone line consisting of 1 1/2 miles of pole line and wire and 1 1/2 miles of wire on foreign poles in Alfalfa County, Oklahoma and 4 1/2 miles of wire on foreign poles and 4 miles of pole line and wire in Woods County, Oklahoma.

A telephone line extending south from Ulysses Compressor Station in Section 28-T.28S-R.28W, Grant County, Kansas to the Stanford Gasoline Plant in Section 5-T.28S-R.38W, Grant County, Kansas, comprising 2 1/2 miles of telephone wire on Company poles.
