

NOW, If said part y of the first part shall pay, or cause to be paid, to said part y of the second part, its heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect.
