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overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to said parties of the First Part, their heirs and assigns.

The purpose of this mortgage is to secure performance by parties of the First Part of their obligations under the terms of said written agreement this date executed by them and delivered to party of the Second Part, and to secure the payment by them to party of the Second part of all sums which may from time to time be paid by party of the Second Part on behalf of parties of the First Part under the terms of said written agreement, with interest.
