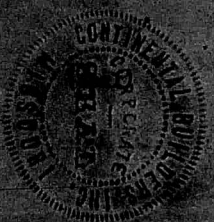


FOR VALUE Received, we hereby sell, transfer and assign to

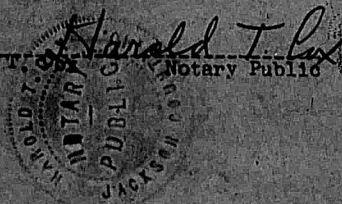
