Including the rents, issues and profits thereof provided however that the Mortgagors shall be entitled to collect and retain the rents, issues and profits until default hereunder.

And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all parties making lawful claim thereto.

IT IS AGREED between the parties hereto that the parties of the first part shall at all times during the life of this indenture, pay all taxes and assessments that may be leried or assessed against said real estate men the same becomes due and payable, and that they will keep the buildings upon said real estatemented against fire and tornado in such sum and by usch insurance company as shall be specified and directed by the party of the second part, the loss, if any, made payable to the party of the second part to the extent of its interest. And in the event that said parties of the first part shall fail to pay such taxes when the same become due and payable or to keep said premises insured as herein provided, then the party of the second part may pay said taxes and insurance, or either, and the amount so paid shall become a part of the indebtedness, secured by this indenture, and shall been interest at the rate of 10% per annum from the date of payment until fully repaid.

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
