this indenture do GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and MORTGAGE to the said parties of the second part, the
following described real estate situated and being in the County of Douglas and State of
Kansas, to-wit: Commencing 80 rods East of a point 16 chains and 80 links North of the
Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 2, Township 14, Range 19, thence
South 27.20 rods; thence West 28 rods; thence North 27.20 rods; thence East to the place
