**This Indenture**, Made this 16th day of September  
A. D. 1960, between Max Miller Thomas and Nancy Carol Thomas, husband and wife

of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, parties  
of the first part, and Laura Paulen Howell, a single woman, and Frances Howell Slavens, a  
single woman, as joint tenants with right of survivorship and not as tenants in common, parties  
of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$2,000.00) DOLLARS,  
to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and Mortgage to the said party of the second part their heirs and assigns forever,  
all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of  
Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot Ninety-two (92) in Breezedale, an addition  
to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.  
And the said Max Miller Thomas and Nancy Carol Thomas, husband and wife  
do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof that they are the lawful owner of  
the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all  
incumbrances except for a first mortgage to Capitol Federal Savings & Loan Association in the  
original sum of \$6,400, dated September 26, 1947 and recorded September 30, 1947  
in Book 73, page 45 and a second mortgage to Capitol Federal Savings & Loan Association in the  
principal sum of \$2,000, dated May 1, 1948 and recorded May 5, 1948 in Book 94, page 144-6,  
both mortgages recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Douglas County, Kansas.  
This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of Two thousand and no/100 (\$2,000.00)  
Dollars, according to the terms of a certain mortgage note this day executed and delivered by the  
said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part

as herein specified. But if default be made in such payments or in part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or  
if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become  
due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner pre-  
scribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest,  
together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of the first part,  
making such sale, on demand to said parties of the first part,

their heirs and assigns
