THIS MORTGAGE made this 3rd day of October, 1960

by and between J. V. McQUEENIE COMPANY, INC., a Kansas Corporation,

of the County of Johnson and State of Kansas  
hereinafter called the Mortgagor(s), and FIRST MORTGAGE INVESTMENT COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri, hereinafter called the Mortgagee,

Witnesseth:

That said Mortgagor(s), for and in consideration of the sum of - - - - -

FIFTEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 - - - - - Dollars (\$ 15,000.00 )

to it in hand paid by said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do es hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Mortgagee all that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements now thereon or that may hereafter be erected thereon and all rents, issues and profits arising therefrom situate, lying and being in the County of Douglas State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lots One (1), Two (2) and Three (3) in Block Three (3) in SOUTHRIDGE ADDITION NO. TWO (2), an Addition to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and

Lots Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15) and Sixteen (16), in Block Two (2) in SOUTHRIDGE ADDITION NO. TWO (2), an Addition to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

To Have and to Hold the Same unto said Mortgagee together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, and all the estate, right, title and interest of said Mortgagor(s) in and to the said described premises and the streets and alleys adjoining or adjacent to the same. And it is mutually covenanted and agreed between said Mortgagor(s) and said Mortgagee that all gas, air conditioning and electric fixtures, radiators, heaters, pumps, engines and machinery, boilers, furnaces, thermostats, elevators and motors, bathtubs, sinks, water closets, basins, pipes, faucets and all other plumbing and heating fixtures, wall or door beds, mirrors, mantels, storm windows, storm doors, window screens, screen doors, blinds, window shades, awnings, and all other goods and chattels and personal property as are ever furnished by a landlord in letting or operating an unfurnished building similar to the one now or hereafter on said premises, which are or shall be attached to said building by nails, screws, bolts, pipe connections, masonry, or in any other manner, are and shall be deemed to be fixtures and an accession to the freehold and a part of the realty as between the parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators, trustees, successors or assigns, and all persons claiming by, through or under them, and shall be deemed to be a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned and to be covered by this mortgage.

The said Mortgagor(s) do es hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof it is the lawful owner of the premises herein granted; that the premises are free and clear of all encumbrances of every nature and kind whatsoever; that it will forever warrant and defend the same with appurtenances unto said Mortgagee against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, and that they hereby waive all benefits of the homestead, exemption and staylaws of the State of Kansas.
