This indenture, made this 26 day of april, 1961, between Delbert A. Elbels and Laverne I. Elsels, husband and wife; of Lawrence in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, parties of the first part, and Erwin C. Thoren, a single person, of Eadorn, in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, party of the second part.

SITNESSETH that said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant bargain, sell, and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, the following described real estate, situated in Douglas County and State of Kanazas, to wit: The South Firthern fest (15') of Lot Two (2), and the North Sixty Feet (60') of Lot Three (3), in Billcreat, an addition to the City of Lawrence Douglas County Kanaza;

subject to a First Mortgage due and peing to the Lawrence National Bank, Lawrence, Kansas, reducied in Book 112, Page 330, of the Mortgage Register in the Mecorder of Deeds Office of Douglas County, State of Kansas.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular tenements and hereditaments thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, forever.

Provided, slways, and these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said Delbert A. Bisele, has this day executed and delivered his certain promissory note, in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following is a copy:

For value received I provise to pay Ervin C. Theren, or order, at the Lawrence National Bank, in Lawrence, Kansas, the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00), on or before May 1, 1967, plus interest on the unpaid balance at the rate of five per cent (54) per annum on the first day of May 1962, and on the first day of May of each year thereafter until said total sum with interest is paid in full.

If default is made in any payment of interest or principal when due the whole sum then unpaid on this note shall immediately become due and payable. The drawers and endorsers severally waive presentment for payment, protest and notice of dishonor in case of nonpayment.

Now if said parties of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, his heirs or assigns, said uum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and inferent " thereon, shall and by these presents become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to take possession of said premises.
