MORTGAGE

THIS INDENTURE, Made this <u>10</u> day of <u>May</u>, 1961, between J. Eldon Fields, Ambrose Saricks, Carol Worth, Alvin Schild, Leland Miller, Martha Hood, Melvin Mencher and Duane Postlethwaite as members of the Executive Committee of the Unitarian Fellowship of Lawrence, Inc., also known as The Lawrence Unitarian Fellowship of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, party of the first part, and the Iowa Unitarian Association, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by this indenture do GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and MORTGAGE to the said party of the second part, the following described real estate situated and being in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Section line 444 feet East of the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty-Six (26), Township Thirteen (13) South, Range Nineteen (19) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian; thence South 290.4 feet; thence East 150 feet; thence North 105.4 feet; thence East 330 feet; thence North 165 feet; thence West 330 feet; thence North 20 feet; thence West 150 feet to the point of beginning, in Douglas County, Kansas

with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.

And the said party of the first part does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof it is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, subject to one certain mortgage in favor of the American Unitarian Association, dated and recorded April 20, 1961 in Book 127 of Mortgages at page 180 of the records in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas to secure payment of the sum of \$7,500.00, and subject only to said mortgage it will warrant and defend the same against all parties making lawful claim thereto.

It is agreed between the parties hereto that the party of the first part shall at all times during the life of this indenture, pay all taxes and assessments that may be levied or assessed against said real estate when the same becomes due and payable, and that it will keep the buildings upon said real estate insured against fire and
