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by the Mortgagor as provided in section 1 of article I of this Mortgage, the Mortgagor will not, without the consent of the holder or holders of not less than a majority in principal amount of the notes at the time outstanding, charge, assign, pledge, mortgage or otherwise encumber any of its property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, wherever situate, which at the time is, or at any time may become, subject to the lien of this Mortgage.

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SECTION 4. The Martgager will duly and punctually pay the principal of and interest on the notes at the dates and places and in the manner provided therein, according to the true intent and meaning thereof, and all other sums becoming due hersunder.

SECTION 5. The Mortgagor will at all times, so long as any of the notes thall be outstanding, take or cause to be taken all such action as from time to the may be necessary to preserve its corporate existence and to preserve and reme all franchises, rights of way, essements, partite, and licenses now or hereafter to its granted or upon it conferred, and will comply with all valid laws, ordi-mances, regulations, and requirements applicable to it or its property.
