

indentures supplemental thereto (hereinafter sometimes collectively called "the Indenture") according to their tenor, purport and effect, and to declare upon the terms and conditions upon and subject to which Bonds are to be issued and secured, the Company has executed and delivered this Supplemental Indenture, and by these presents grants, bargains, sells, warrants, aliens, releases, conveys, assigns, transfers, mortgages, pledges, sets over and ratifies and confirms unto Harris Trust and Savings Bank, as Trustee, and to its successors in Trust under the Indenture forever, all and singular the following described properties (in addition to all other properties heretofore specifically subjected to the lien of the Indenture and not heretofore released from the lien thereof), that is to say:

FIRST.

All and singular the rents, real estate, chattels real, easements, servitudes, and leaseholds and other interests in real estate of the Company hereinafter enumerated, or which, subject to the provisions of Article XII of the Original Indenture, the Company may hereafter acquire, including among other things, the following property located in the State of Kansas, together with all improvements of any type located thereon:

PARCELS OF REAL ESTATE

The following described parcels of real estate, all of which are located in the State of Kansas in the respective counties hereinafter specified:

DECATUR COUNTY

1. *Abilene Office Building Site:* Lot Eight (8), Broadway Street, Augustime and Lebold's Subdivision of Thompson and McCoy's Addition to the City of Abilene, as the same is located upon the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Thirteen (13) South, Range Two (2) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian.

2. *Electric Substation Site:* Lot No. 43, on Fourth Street, Original Town of Solomon, less highway.

3. *Other Real Estate:* A strip 10 feet wide across Lot Eight (8) of Section 27, Township 13 South, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M., as now located and used as a drainage ditch to the river.

DECATUR COUNTY

4. *Electric Substation Site:* Beginning at the Northeast Corner of the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Block Forty-eight (48) in that part of the City of Lawrence known as West Lawrence, thence South Seventy-five (75) feet; thence West Seventy-five (75) feet; thence North Seventy-five (75) feet; thence East Seventy-five (75) feet to the point of beginning.

5. *Electric Substation Site:* Beginning at a point 10.32 feet South of the intersection of the West line of Oregon Street and the East and West center line of Block 3, Earl's Addition, an addition to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, thence South on the West line of Oregon Street a distance of Seventy (70) feet, thence West parallel with the center line of said Block 3, a distance of Fifty (50) feet, thence North parallel with the West line of Oregon Street a distance of Seventy (70) feet, thence East to the point of beginning.

6. *Electric Substation Site:* Beginning at a point on the North line of the right of way of Kansas Highway #10, which point is 73.8 feet North and 327 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section Six (6), in Township Thirteen (13) South, Range Twenty (20) East, thence West along the North right of way line of said Highway a distance of 100 feet; thence North parallel with the East line of said Section 6, a distance of 150 feet; thence East parallel with the north right of way line of said Highway a distance of 100 feet; thence South to point of beginning.

7. *Office Building Site:* Lots Ninety-eight (98), One Hundred (100) and One Hundred Two (102) on Tennessee Street, in the City of Lawrence.

8. *Electric Substation Site:* Beginning at a point 198 feet North of the Southeast corner of Section 34, Township 12 South, Range 19 East, thence West parallel with the South line of said Section 34 a distance of 297 feet; thence North parallel with the East line of said Section 34 a distance of 466 feet, thence East parallel with the South line of said Section 34 a distance of 297 feet, thence South to point of beginning.
