

southwest corner of Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 10 West, Rice County; extending south through Sections 4, 8, 17, and 20, Township 20 South, Range 10 West, Rice County, to a point in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 20; thence continuing southeasterly to the Arapahoe Pipe Line electric substation of the Company located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 21 in said township, range and county.

Line No. 6.—Stafford to Preston: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately twelve and one tenth (12.1) miles in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the northeast corner of 16, Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 12 West, Stafford County; extending south to the southeast corner of said Section 24; thence continuing southeasterly to the northeast corner of Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 11 West, Stafford County; thence continuing south through Sections 20 and 31, all in said township, range and county; thence continuing south through Sections 6 and 7, Township 25 South, Range 11 West, Stafford County, to the northwest corner of Section 18; thence continuing east to the northwest corner of Section 17; thence continuing south through Sections 17, 20, 29 and 32, all in said township, range and county; thence continuing south to a point in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 6, Township 26 South, Range 11 West, Pratt County; thence continuing east to the northwest corner of Section 5; thence south through Sections 5 and 8 to a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the northwest corner of Section 17, all in said township, range and county.

Line No. 7.—Larned to Larned State Hospital: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately two and seven tenths (2.7) miles in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located in the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, Township 21 South, Range 16 West, Pawnee County; extending west through said Section 31 to the southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 17 West, Pawnee County; thence continuing southeasterly through said Section 28 to a point in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 17 West, Pawnee County; thence continuing southwesterly through said Section 1 to the Larned State Hospital electric substation of the Company, located

in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 2, all in said township, range and county.

Line No. 8.—Seneca to Richmond Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately two and five tenths (2.5) miles in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 33, Township 2 South, Range 12 East, Nemaha County; extending north to the northeast corner of said Section 33; thence continuing northeasterly to a point in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 27, thence continuing north through Sections 27 and 22 to the northwest corner of said Section 22; thence continuing east to the Richmond electric substation of the Company located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 22, all in said township, range and county.

Line No. 9.—Sunrise Substation to Smoky Hill Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately two and ninety-five hundredths (2.95) miles in length, beginning at the Sunrise electric substation of the Company located in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 25, Township 14 South, Range 3 West, Saline County; extending south to a point in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 25; thence continuing east to the southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 29, Township 14 South, Range 2 West, Saline County; thence continuing south through Sections 29 and 31 to the southwest corner of said Section 31, all in said township, range and county; thence continuing west to the Smoky Hill electric substation of the Company located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 3 West, Saline County.

Line No. 10.—Tap to Smoky Hill Substation: A 69,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately one tenth (1) of a mile in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 69,000 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 36, Township 14 South, Range 3 West, Saline County; extending east to the Smoky Hill electric substation of the Company located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 36, in said township, range and county.

Line No. 11.—Tap to Smoky Hill Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately one tenth (1)
