

beginning with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 11 East, Leavenworth County, extending south to a point in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 10; thence continuing west to the Emporia State Teachers College electric substation of the Company, located in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 10, in said township, range and county.

Line No. 20.—Goodyear Junction Substation to Goodyear Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately fifty-two hundredths (52) miles in length beginning at the Goodyear Junction Substation, located in the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 13, Township 11 South, Range 13 East, Shawnee County, extending east to a point in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township, range and county; thence continuing southeasterly to a point in said section, township, range and county; thence continuing west to the Goodyear Electric Substation (No. 22) of the Company, located in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township, range and county.

Line No. 21.—2nd Street Substation to Metropolitan Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately one and sixty-eight hundredths (1.68) miles in length beginning at the 2nd Street Substation of the Company, located near the intersection of 2nd Street and Walnut Street, Leavenworth, Kansas, extending north to the Fort Leavenworth boundary, thence west to the Metropolitan Substation of the Company, located near the intersection of Broadway Street and Metropolitan Street, Leavenworth, Kansas.

Line No. 22.—Clay Center Junction to Clay Center C & W REA Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole electric transmission line, approximately seven and ten hundredths (7.10) miles in length beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the northeast corner of Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 3 East, Clay County, extending southeasterly through Sections 26, 17, 8 and 5 in said township, range and county; thence continuing north through Section 22, 20 and 12, Township 8 South, Range 3 East, Clay County, to the Clay Center C & W REA Substation of the Company, located in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 19.

Line No. 23.—Glathie Substation to Church Street Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately

one and twenty-one hundredths (1.21) miles in length beginning from the Glathie Substation of the Company, located at the intersection of Willie Street and Park Street, Glathie, Kansas, extending to the Church Street Substation of the Company, located at the intersection of Santa Fe Street and the St. L. and S. F. RR., Glathie, Kansas.

Line No. 24.—Thornton Street Junction to Thornton Street Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, double circuit, electric transmission line approximately one and thirty hundredths (1.30) miles in length beginning at a point of connection with a present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located at the intersection of 1st Street and Marion Street, Leavenworth, Kansas, extending west to the Thornton Street Substation of the Company, located near the intersection of Thornton Street and Spring Garden Avenue, Leavenworth.

Line No. 25.—Tap to Jayhawk Pipeline Company Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately one and five hundredths (.25) of a mile in length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 9 West, Rice County, extending south to the Jayhawk Pipeline Company Substation of the Company, located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township, range and county.

Line No. 26.—Tap to Bushlon Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately forty-four hundredths (.44) of a mile in length beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located in the northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 2, Township 18 South, Range 10 West, Rice County, extending south through Section 2 to the Bushlon Substation of the Company, located in the same section, township, range and county.

Line No. 27.—Glathie Substation to Deleo Remy Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately one and two hundredths (1.02) miles in length beginning from the Glathie Substation of the Company located at the intersection of Willie Street and Park Street, Glathie, Kansas, extending east to the Deleo Remy Company Substation of the Company, located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 33, Township 13 South, Range 23 East, Johnson County.
