

Line No. 28.—Tap to Edge Steel Products Company Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately ten hundredths (10) of a mile in length beginning from a point of connection with the existing 34,500 volt, electric transmission line of the Company located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 25, Township 13 South, Range 23 East, Johnson County, extending east to the Edge Steel Products Company Substation, of the Company, located near Kansas and Oak Street, Olathe, Kansas.

Line No. 29.—Larned City Substation to Larned City Interconnection Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately five hundredths (5) of a mile in length extending from the Larned City Substation, of the Company, located at the intersection of 2nd Street and Santa Fe Street to Larned City Interconnection Substation, of the Company, located near the intersection of 3rd Street and Santa Fe Street, Larned, Kansas.

Line No. 30.—St. Johns Compressor Station Substation to St. Johns Interconnection Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately one and seven hundredths (1.07) miles in length beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line, of the Company, located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 13 West, Stafford County, extending north to the northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 4; thence continuing west to the center of said Section 4; thence continuing north to the intersection of Lamoreaux Avenue and Prairie Street, St. Johns, Kansas; thence continuing west to the intersection of Main Street and Lamoreaux Avenue; thence continuing north to the St. Johns Interconnection Substation, of the Company, located near the intersection of the A.T. & S.F. RR. right of way and Main Street, all in the same township, range and county.

Line No. 31.—South Macksville Substation to Kinsley Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately twenty-three and fifty hundredths (23.50) miles in length beginning at the South Macksville Substation, of the Company, located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 22, Township 24 South, Range 15 West, Stafford County, extending west through Sections 24, 20, and 19, same township, range and county; thence continuing west through Sections 24, 23, 22, 21, 20 and 30, Township 24 South, Range 16 West, Edwards County; thence continuing west through Sections 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30, Township 24 South, Range 17 West, Edwards County; thence continuing southwest

through Section 26, same township, range and county, to a point in the north line of Section 36, Township 24 South, Range 18 West, Edwards County; thence continuing west through Sections 36, 35, 34, 33, 32, and 31, same township, range and county; thence continuing west through Sections 36, 26, and 34, Township 24 South, Range 19 West, Edwards County, to the intersection of 1st Street and Elizabeth Street, Kinsley, Kansas; thence south to the intersection of 2nd Street and Elizabeth Street, thence west to the Kinsley Substation, of the Company, located near the intersection of 2nd Street and Briggs Street, Kinsley, Kansas, in same township, range and county.

Line No. 32.—Tap to Mid-America Pipeline Company Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately eighty-three hundredths (83) of a mile in length beginning from a point of connection with a present 34,500 volt electric transmission line, of the Company, located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 5 West, McPherson County, extending south to the Mid-America Pipeline Company Substation, of the Company, located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 24.

Line No. 33.—Tap to Buildex Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately two and seventy-nine hundredths (2.79) miles in length beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located in the northwest corner of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 14 West, McPherson County, extending north through Sections 17 and 8 to the southwest corner of said Section 8; thence continuing west through Section 7 to a point in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 7; thence continuing north to the Buildex Substation, of the Company, located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 6, all in same township, range and county.

Line No. 34.—West 17th Street Switching Station and 17th and Fairlawn Substation: A 115,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately three miles (3) in length at the West 17th Street Switching Station of the Company located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 6, Township 12 South, Range 13 East, Shawnee County, extending east through Sections 1, 5, 4 and 3 to the 17th and Fairlawn Substation of the Company, located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 3, same township, range and county.
