

Line No. 57—14th and Brady Street Junction to 3rd & Washington Street Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole electric transmission line approximately two and thirty-four hundredths (2.34) miles in length extending from the 14th and Brady Street Substation, of the Company, to the 3rd and Washington Street Substation, of the Company, Abilene, Kansas.

Line No. 58—North Street Junction to Sunrise Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately three and twenty-eight hundredths (3.28) miles in length beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company, located on North Street in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, Township 14 South, Range 2 West, Saline County, extending south to the Sunrise Substation, of the Company, located at the intersection of Albert and Rouch Streets, Saline, Kansas.

Line No. 59—Tap of 4th & Walnut Street Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately one and forty-two hundredths (1.42) miles in length beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line of the Company located at the intersection of Crawford & Ohio Streets, extending to the 4th and Walnut Street Substation, Salina, Kansas.

Line No. 60—South Avenue Junction to Great Lakes Pipeline Company Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, length, beginning at a point of connection with the present 34,500 volt electric transmission line, of the Company, located in the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 17, Township 19 South, Range 11 East, Lyon County, extending north to the north Highway-Way line of U. S. Highway 268, located in the southeast corner of Section 8, same township, range, and county; thence continuing northwest along said Highway 268, south to the northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 18, same township, range, and county; thence continuing north to the south Right-of-Way line of U. S. Highway 268 Bypass; thence northwesterly along the south Right-of-Way line of said Highway 268 Bypass to 15th Street; thence east on 15th Street to the Great Lakes Pipeline Co. Substation, of the Company, located on West 15th Street, Emporia, Kansas, all in same township, range and county.

beginning at the Underpass Switching Station, of the Company, located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 19, Township 22 South, Range 16 East, Shawnee County, extending west to the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24, Township 12 South, Range 15 East, Shawnee County; thence continuing south through Sections 24, 25 and 26 to a point in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 35; thence continuing southeast to a point in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, Township 12 South, Range 16 East, Shawnee County; thence continuing south through said Section 31; thence continuing south to Forbes Air Force Base Substation, of the Company, located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 6, Township 13 South, Range 16 East, Shawnee County.

Line No. 31—Section 155 KV Substation to Service Pipeline Company Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately one hundredth (.01) of a mile in length beginning at the Section 155 KV Substation, of the Company, located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 27, Township 15 South, Range 15 East, Osage County, extending west to the Service Pipeline Company Substation, of the Company, located in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 28, same township, range and county.

Line No. 34—2nd and Market Street Substation to Emporia State Teachers College Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately one and two hundredths (1.02) miles in length extending from the 2nd and Market Street Substation, of the Company, to the Emporia State Teachers College Substation, of the Company, located at 11th and Market Street, Emporia, Kansas.

Line No. 55—Emporia 2nd and Market Substation to Emporia Plant Substation: A 34,500 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately five hundredths (.05) of a mile in length extending from the 2nd and Market Substation, of the Company, to the Emporia Plant Substation, of the Company, both located near the intersection of 2nd and Market Street, Emporia, Kansas.

Line No. 56—Tap to 15th Street Substation: A 69,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line approximately seven hundredths (.07) of a mile in length beginning at a point of connection with the present 69,000 volt electric transmission line of the Company located in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 34, Township 12 South, Range 19 East, Douglas County; extending west to the 15th Street Substation, of the Company, located in same quarter section, township, range, and county.
