

jurisdiction; and the Party of the First Part, for itself, and all who may claim under it insofar as that it or they now hereafter may lawfully waive all the benefits of such laws.

The terms and provisions hereof shall be binding upon Party of the First Part, its successors and assigns, and shall inure to the benefit of Party of the Second Part, its successors and assigns, and all other holders of the indebtedness secured hereby or any party thereof.
