Shurber by deed dated the 13th day of March A.D. 1884, and described as follows.

Beginning at the N.E. corner of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31, T. 13, R. 18. = thence South 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ % chains to a stake in Centre of Road - thence West 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ % chains to a stake in Centre of Lawrence Road - thence South West along the Centre of said Road 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ % chains to a stake - thence North 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ % chains to a stake in centre of Road - thence East 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ % chains to the place of beginning containing forty acres.
