(\$500.00) Dollars, to him duly paid, the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged, has solds and by these
presents does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to
the said party of the second part, his heirs
and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of
land situated in the County of Douglas and State
of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:
