singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto
belonging, unto the party of the second part and
to her heirs and assigns, forever. And the said
Parties of the first part do hereby covenant and
agree, that at the delivery hereof they are the
lawful owners of the premises above granted, and
seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inher-
itance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances,
and that they will Warrant and Defend the same
in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party
her heirs and assigns forever, against all persons
lawfully claiming the same.

upon this express condition, that whereas, the said
