

This Indenture, Made this 14th day of July in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and eighty six between Edwin R. Snyder and
Mollie D. Snyder his wife of Baldwin in the County
of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part:
and Henry M. Granger of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the
first part, in consideration of the sum of
Seven Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have
sold and by these presents do grant, bargain,
sell and mortgage to the said party of the
second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all
that tract or parcel of land situated in the
County of Douglas and State of Kansas described
as follows, to-wit:

The North Fifty (50) feet of Lot number
Seventy seven (77) Seventy nine (79) and Eighty one
(81) Indiana Street in Baldwin City
with the appurtenances and all the estates,
title and interest of the said parties of the
first part therein. And the said Edwin R. Snyder
does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery
hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises
above granted and seized of a good and inde-
=fearable estate of inheritance therein, free and
clear of all incumbrances and that he will
warrant and defend the same against all
claims whatsoever. This Grant is intended as
a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum
of Seven Hundred Dollars, according to the
terms of one certain promissory note this day
executed by the said Edwin R. and Mollie D.
Snyder to the said party of the second part.
Said note being given for the sum of Seven
Hundred ~~for~~ Dollars, dated July 14th 1886 due and
payable in three years from date thereof, with
interest thereon from the date thereof, until
paid according to the terms of said note and
coupons thereto attached. And this conveyance shall
be void if such payment be made as in said
note and coupons thereto attached, and as is
hereinafter specified. And the said party of the
