This Indenture, Made this 10th day of August A.D. 1886
between John Wilder and Rosanna Wilder his wife
of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas, of the
first part and Penelope Gardner of Douglas County,
in the State of Kansas of the second part;

Witnesseth, That said parties of the first
part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred
and fifty and no Dollars, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the
second part, her heirs and assigns, all the follow-
ing described Real Estate, situated in Douglas
County, and State of Kansas to wit:

Lots numbered two(2) and fourteen (14)
and the north fifteen (15) feet of lots numbered
three (3) and thirteen (13) all in Block numbered
one hundred and forty six (146) in the City
of Eudora, according to the plat of said city
on file in the office of Register of Deeds of
Douglas County, Kansas.

To have and to Hold the same, together
with all and singular the tenements, heredita-
ments and appurtenances therunto belonging,
or in anywise appertaining, forever:

upon this express condition, that whereas said
