

North Fifty (50) feet, thence West One hundred and
Seventeen (117) feet, thence South Fifty (50) feet, thence
East One hundred and Seventeen (117) feet to place
of beginning

To have and to hold the same with all and
singular the emblements, hereditaments and appur-
tenances therunto belonging, or in anywise appertain-
ing, and all rights of homestead exemption unto
the said party of the second part, and to its rep-
resentatives or assigns forever. And the said party
of the first part do hereby covenant and agree,
that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners
of the premises above granted, and seized of a good
and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and
clear of all incumbrances, and that they will
warrant and defend the same in the quiet and
peaceable possession of said party of the second
part, its representatives or assigns forever against
the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

Provided always, And this instrument is made
executed and delivered upon the following express
conditions, to wit:

First: Said party of the first part are
justly indebted unto the said party of the second
part in the principal sum of Two Hundred ⁰⁰
Dollars, lawful money of the United States of
America, being for a loan thereof, made by the
said party of the second part to the said
party of the first part, and payable according
to the tenor and effect of a certain First Mort-
gage Real Estate Note, dated the 2nd day of
August A.D. 1886, numbered 4828 executed and de-
livered by the said party of the first part,
and payable to the order of the said party of
the second part, five years after date, at the
office of the National Loan and Trust Company,
in Topeka, Kansas, with exchange on New York,
with interest thereon from date until maturity
at the rate of seven per cent. per annum,
payable semi-annually, on the 2nd days of February
and August in each year, and twelve per cent
per annum after maturity, the instalment of
interest being further evidenced by ten coupons
