

This Indenture, Made this first day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and eighty six, between George Mosley
and Mary C. Mosley husband & wife of Baldwin
City in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas
of the first part and William E. Chamberlin of
the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first
part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred
and fifty Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
mortgage to the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or
parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas
and State of Kansas, described as follows to-wit;

Lots No Seventy one (71) Seventy two (72) and
Seventy three (73) High Street Baldwin City
with all the appurtenances, and all the estate,
title and interest of the said parties of the
first part therein. And the said George Mosley
& Mary C. Mosley do hereby covenant and agree
that at the delivery hereof they were the law-
ful owners of the premises above granted, and
seized of a good and indefeasible estate of in-
heritance therein free and clear of all in-
cumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to
secure the payment of the sum of one hundred
and fifty dollars according to the terms of
one certain promissory note this day executed
and delivered by the said George Mosley
and Mary C. Mosley to the said party of the
second part; said note due 3 years after
date and bearing 12% int from date,
payable semi-annually according to six coupon
notes attached. and this conveyance shall
be void if such payments be made as herein
specified. But if default be made in such
payment, or any part thereof, or interest hereon,
or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept
up thereon, then this conveyance shall become
absolute and the whole amount shall become
