But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due; and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall, and by these presents become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises; And said parties of the first part further agree upon default of the above covenant and conditions, or any or either of them to pay the sum of Fifty  $\therefore$  Dollars, for the mortgagee or his assigns, attorney's fees or the foreclosure of this mortgage, which sum shall be a lien upon said premises, added to the amount of said obligation and secured by these presents, and shall be included in and operate as a part of the judgment upon foreclosure of mortgage.
