of the State of Massachusetts of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the party of the first part in considera-
tion of the sum of Two hundred Dollars, to him in hand paid,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party
of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, the following tract
or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of
Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Lot One hundred and Seventy eight (178) on Ohio Street in the
City of Lawrence Kans.

with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of
the said party of the first part therein. And the said party of the
first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof
he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized
of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and
clear of all incumbrances; that he has good right to sell and
convey said premises, and that he will WARRANT and DEFEND the
same against the lawful claims of all persons.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of
