This Indenture, Made this Twenty second day of October
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and eighty six, between Marshfield Atkinson and
Caroline Atkinson Husband and Wife of the County
of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part,
and Crippen, Lawrence & Co., of Concord, New Hampshire,
of the second part;

Witnesseth, that the parties of the first
part, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred
Dollars, to them in hand paid by the parties
of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the parties
of the second part their heirs and assigns forever,
all that tract or parcel of land situated in
the County of Douglas and State of Kansas,
described as follows, to wit:
